

Marvin E. and Pauline Beekman 2017 Fellowship Award

Marvin E. Beekman has long been recognized nationally as a pioneer in the field of education for persons with disabilities, having served as a teacher and the Lansing School District's Director of Special Education for 36 years. The Board of Trustees of the Lansing Educational Advancement Foundation are pleased to announce the 15th year of funding for the Marvin E. & Pauline Beekman Fellowship Award. Awards will be made on the merit of the application and the value the proposed training will provide in order to better serve students with disabilities in the Lansing School District. Award amounts can vary, however the average award is \$500.00.

- ➤ All district personnel directly or indirectly involved with students with disabilities may apply
- Fellowships should be designed to enhance the delivery services to students who have special needs and the professional development opportunity will allow the staff member to enhance their ability to work with students with disabilities in the Lansing School District.
- Awards will be made for full or partial cost reimbursement for the following:
 - Topical conferences
 - Workshops
 - o Seminars
 - Class Study
- A selection committee will review all applications on a competitive basis, using a rubric
- The application must be filled out completely and signed by the applicants supervisor
- Applications may be sent by courier or mailed to the LEAF office at Beekman Center 2901 Wabash Road Lansing, MI 48910
- > Deadline for submission is 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 24, 2017
- Award recipients will be notified of their acceptance at the end of March and awards will be presented at the Annual LEAF event on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, 6:00-8:00 pm at the Country Club of Lansing.
- Awards must be expended by December 14, 2018.
- At the conclusion of the activity, the applicant will be required to furnish a brief report.
- Funds for this fellowship award have been available through contributions to the Marvin E. & Pauline E. Beekman Memorial Fund.
