- ➤ Fellowships should be designed to provide a professional development opportunity so that a staff member can enhance their ability to work with students in the Lansing School District. Additional points will be awarded for staff who choose a program that address's K 3 Reading Readiness.
- Awards will be made for full or partial cost reimbursement for the following:
  - Topical conferences
  - Workshops
  - Seminars
  - Class Study
- A selection committee will review all applications on a competitive basis, using a rubric
- The application must be filled out completely and signed by the applicants supervisor
- Applications may be sent by courier or mailed to the LEAF office at Beekman Center 2901 Wabash Road Lansing, MI 48910
- ➤ Deadline for submission is 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 24, 2017
- Award recipients will be notified of their acceptance at the end of March and awards will be presented at the annual LEAF event.
- > Awards must be expended by December 14, 2018.
- > At the conclusion of the activity, the applicant will be required to furnish receipts and a brief report.
